



# Behind on **child support** and need your **license reinstated**?

*Here's your chance to get*

## On the Road Again

For a limited time beginning August 1, the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services is offering an opportunity for payors of child support (Non-Custodial Parents) whose driver's licenses have been administratively suspended to get your license reinstated for a reduced amount.

### How it works

For each case, pay

- Two months of court-ordered child support, and
- \$100 toward arrears or past-due support, and
- Administrative fee, if court ordered

*This payment does not include any reinstatement fees or fines that may be required by the Louisiana Office of Motor Vehicles.*

### Get started

Speak with your caseworker to determine the exact amount needed to qualify.
